- Double-sided vinyl banners with individual photographs of veterans preferably in Military uniform with their branch and specific war/conflict would be displayed on lamp posts in town.
- Eligibility: veteran who is a current resident or has lived here in the past.
- Cost \$40 per veteran
- Application process includes submission of (copies) DD 214 form & photograph of veteran preferably in Military uniform.
- Applications reviewed by McCormick County Veterans Affairs to confirm DD 214 and dates of service for authenticity.

McCormick has a rich heritage that includes many service members from all branches of military service throughout the years. For Veterans Day 2024, the McCormick County Office of Veterans Affairs is sponsoring a HOMETOWN HEROES BANNER PROGRAM to honor the veterans past and present who were from McCormick County or who now make their home here.

Each banner will feature a picture of the veteran (preferably in uniform), branch of service, and era of service and will cost \$40 each for a double-sided banner. They will be displayed around the main downtown area of the Town of McCormick on the light fixtures. With that in mind, there will be a limited number of available spaces, so this will be a first come, first served basis. It is my hope to have the banners displayed for one month during the Veterans Day celebration.
