County Ordinances:

Sec. 32-70. - Addressing criteria

- (a) Each house, building or other occupied structure must be assigned a separate address number. A number or alphabetical letter must be assigned for each separate occupant within a building or other occupied structure. Examples include apartments, companies, etc.
- (b) Written notification from the county of the proper address of each house, building, or structure must be given to its owner. Owners are responsible to notify occupants, or agents of occupants in all instances where a new number has been assigned.
- (c) The owner, occupant, or agent of each house, building, or other structure assigned a number shall place or cause to be placed, said number on the premises within 21 days after receiving notification of the proper number assignment in accordance with subsection 32-70(e).
- (d) Costs and installation of the number are the responsibility of the property owner or occupant. Residential numbers must not be less than three inches in height. Business numbers must not be less than four inches in height. All numbers must be made of a durable, clearly visible, reflective material.
- (e) Numbers must be conspicuously placed:
- (1) Numbers shall be conspicuously placed at the walk, driveway, or other appropriate place so as to be clearly visible from the road. In all cases, the designated McCormick County Official shall be the final judge what "appropriate place" shall mean if questions arise.
- (2) Where more than one residence, building or other occupied structure share the same drive, numbers for all residences, buildings or other occupied structures shall be placed at the walk, driveway, or other appropriate place so as to be clearly visible from the road.
- (3) In all cases, numbers shall be installed on the same side of the road as the building or structure being identified.

Sec. 32-71. - Administration of addressing

- (a) Whenever any principal dwelling or building is erected or located in McCormick County subsequent to the effective date of this article, it will be the duty and responsibility of the owner or owners to obtain the correct address from the E-911 addressing office for the property, and to immediately install the numbers as described in this article. No building permit or occupancy permit shall be issued for any dwelling or building until the owner has obtained the official address from the E-911 addressing office.
- (b) Final approval of any structure erected, altered, repaired or modified after the effective date of this article shall be withheld until proper address numbers have been assigned by the E-911 addressing office and installed as outlined in this article.
